In addition to the main lounge and dining area there are smaller lounge areas with television, lounge chairs and air conditioning for consumers to use as well as the solarium overlooking a beautiful outdoor terrace.</p> <p>Some rooms are located in a secure area, with an outside secure garden area including a gazebo, walking paths and outdoor eating area.</p> <p>The chapel is a place where consumers can attend scheduled church services weekly for different religions. There are also scheduled activities in the main lounge room and chapel area which include a daily well being program, craft, visiting entertainers, hoy, shuffle board, book readings and exercise programs.</p>
