Description of quality, condition and amenity of room	Our Standard Shared rooms are air conditioned, all come equipped with two single adjustable beds, overbed tables, bedside tables, private ensuite, two spacious built-in wardrobes and telephone provisioning. All consumers are issued with a call bell to access medical staff 24/7.

Description of quality, condition, size and amenity of common areas to which a person living in this room would have access	Consumers have access to a dining room and two large lounge areas on this level with an outdoor terrace overlooking rural pastures to the east and a balcony looking west towards the Watagan Mountains. An activities room is housed on this level with worship services offered in the living room throughout the week and telecast from the local church on Saturday mornings.
Description of any specific accommodation or design features	This facility has a Special Care room for consumers who need it on a temporary basis. It is equipped with an onsite fold out bed available on request for a family member that may choose to stay. The room also comes with a television and telephone provisioning.
Description of any additional care or services offered at no additional cost	There is an onsite social worker, chaplain, hospitality and lifestyle team.
Are there any services offered with the room at additional cost? If so, list with cost associated.	For an additional cost, consumers can participate in bus outings and see the onsite hair dresser.

Explanation of payment options	Consumers can choose to pay for their accommodation by a refundable deposit, a daily payment, or a combination of both. A refundable deposit is paid as a lump sum amount. A daily payment accrues daily and is paid periodically, for example monthly. A combination payment includes both a partial lump sum and daily payments.

Example of a combination payment for room	For this room a consumer could pay, for example, 50% of the price by a refundable deposit of \$212,500 and 50% of the price by daily payments of \$44.54.
